

**Concept** - Slide in beside

**Design** - A typical traditional house centrally sited on a large suburban block, with a few metres of less than useful yard either side of the house.

The house was moved two metres sideways to allow a three metre wide addition of a combined linear circulation /accommodation zone from the front to the back of the house through the sequence of spaces: carport-deck-kitchen-living deck-outlook deck.

Removing the major circulation route to the side of the formal room layout of the existing house allowed the existing rooms to become destination spaces rather than transitory spaces.

A low pitched roof rises towards the rear , a directional emphasis towards the garden, greenery behind and the major deck space at the rear.

The linear space progressively becomes less enclosed as you move from the kitchen through to the rear, terminating at a strutted jetty-like deck with a cantilevered roof projecting beyond the rear wall of the house.

A linear skylight reinforces a directional emphasis towards the rear deck.

The mid-point of the journey through the space is a dining setting that forms one end of a larger semi-enclosed external living space. Here, materials and surface treatment creates an ambiguity about typical expectations of the nature of external space.
